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### Resolution on Halal Certificate♦

- 1- There are explicit routes concerning Halal (Permitted) and Haram (Prohibited) in the Shariah. Every Muslim must observe these norms. It is a sin to ignore such Shariah rules. In some Ahadith it has been reported that it will cause the wastage of other good deeds, so every Muslim should be alive in this respect. The institutions that issue Halal certificates must take research measure while issuing such certificate.
- 2- It is permissible to use meat products provided it has been established that the animal was Halal one and was slaughtered in accordance with the norms of the Shariah.
- 3- To issue a Halal certificate to such food products in which Haram (prohibited) ingredients are used, only these who are competent experts and well aware of the concerned Shariah rules, should issue such certificate. A certificate issued by a non Muslim or the one not an expert or competent in this field will have no credibility.
- 4- Muslims must establish their own laboratories to test and check the food products however, the report issued by a competent credible laboratory may be the basis to issue Halal certificate, however it must be ensured that the test and check of the concerned product was carried out under the supervision and expert Muslim.
- 5- To issue a Halal certificate is an act of extreme sensitive responsibility only such an institute can issue such a certificate, where person fearing Allah Almighty and having competence in Shariah commandments jurist and experts in this trade are functioning. They keep a watch on the process of slaughtering and issue Halal certificate after due test and check and ensure constant supervision.

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
