



Maulana Syed Nizamuddin (Rh)

Maulana Syed Nizamuddin was born on 13th March 1927 in a respected family in Gaya district, Bihar, and passed away on 17th October 2015.

He received higher studies from Darul Uloom, Deoband and then started academic career as a teacher, within few years he was appointed as the Nazim (Secretary) of Imarat-e-Shariah of Bihar, Udhisha and Jharkhand by Maulana Saiyed Minnatullah Rahmani (rh). He served the institution as a decent management for a long term, represented the valuable services of Imarat-e- Shariah to the masses of prescribed states and won their trust and hearts; consequently they remained associated with this platform.

Looking at his extraordinary contributions and sincere services, its advisory body nominated him as 7th Ameer-e- Shariat (president) of Imarat-e-Shariah, Bihar-Orissa-Jharkhand in 1998 and he enjoyed the office till the last breath of his life.

He was also appointed General Secretary of All India Muslim Personal Law Board and performed remarkable social and legal services here, he protected the Board from emerging disagreements and ensured the unity and mutual harmony.
