



## **Maulana Muhammad Salim Qasmi (Rh)**

Maulana Muhammad Salim Qasmi was born on 8<sup>th</sup> January 1926 at Deoband in Qasmi family and died on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at the age of 92.

He was great-grandson of Maulana Muhammad Qasim Nanotvi and the eldest son of Maulana Muhammad Tayyib Qasmi (Rh). Being a real successor of knowledge of his lineage, he was given the title of Khatibul Islam (orator of Islam).

He graduated from Darul Uloom Deoband in 1948, among his famous teachers were; Maulana Husain Ahmed Madani (Rh), a literary figure Maulana Izaz Ali Amrohi (Rh), Maulana Ibrahim Balyawi (Rh) and Syed Fakhrul Hasan Moradabadi (Rh).

He was appointed as a teacher at Darul Uloom Deoband just after completion of studies; he thought books of all standards; from primary to higher classes including: Bukhari, Mishkaat, Abu Dawood etc.

In 1982, after conflict arose, he founded Darul Uloom Waqf, Deoband, along with Anzar Shah Kashmiri and served as its rector till the last breath of life.

Along with teaching activities, he played a vigorous role in the field of socio-religious, welfare and legal services.
