## Maulana Saiyed Rabe Hasani Nadwi

Maulana Saiyed Rabe Hasni Nadwi opened his eyes on 1<sup>st</sup> October 1929 at Takya Kalaa, Raye Bareli, UP, he is nephew of Maulana Saiyed Abul Hasan Ali Hasani Nadwi (Rh).

Nadwi gained primary education from his family Maktab at Raye Bareli and joined <u>Darul Uloom Nadwatul Ulama</u> for higher studies and graduated in 1948, for further studies he made journey to Darul Uloom Deoband and spent only one year there.

Nadwi was appointed as Assistant Professor at <u>Nadwatul Ulama</u>, <u>Lucknow</u> in 1952, head of its Arabic Department in 1955, and the Dean of Faculty of Arabic Language in 1970. He became Principle of <u>Nadwatul Ulama</u> in 1993, Deputy-rector in 2000 and Rector after the death of <u>Abul Hasan Ali Nadwi</u> in 2000. He also succeeded a great scholar <u>Mujahidul Islam Qasmi</u> as the President of <u>All India Muslim Personal Law Board</u> in 2002.

Besides a large number of his articles, literatures and drafts, so for 15 valuable books in Arabic and 12 in Urdu have been published.

He made several academic journeys to abroad in the company of Maulana Syed Abul Hasan Ali Hasni Nadwi (Rh) and even after his demise; he attended and addressed a lot of symposiums, seminars and meetings. His favorite topic is Islamic Literary Works. He is the Vice President of the Aalmi Rabita Adab-e-Islami, Riyadh (K.S.A.), and a founding member of Muslim World League Makkah.

He is also president of Majlis-e-Tahqiqat-o-Nashriyat-e-Islam, Lucknow, Deni Talimi Council Up, and Dare Arafat Rae Bareli, and member of "Darul Musannefeen, Azamgarh, Trusty of Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies of Oxford University, and also patron of Tahreek Payam-e-Insaniyet and Islamic Fiqh Academy, India.
